The Royal Albert Hall and Bongo LLP software product(s) identified above include associated software components, media, printed materials, and “online” or electronic documentation (“Showtime”). By installing, copying, or otherwise using Showtime, you agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA. This license agreement represents the entire agreement concerning the program between you, the Royal Albert Hall and Bongo LLP, (referred to as “licenser”), and it supersedes any prior proposal, representation, or understanding between the parties. If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, do not install or use Showtime. Showtime is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. Showtime is licensed, not sold.

I. GRANT OF LICENSE

Showtime is licensed as follows: **(a) Installation and Use.** The Royal Albert Hall and Bongo LLP grants you the non-exclusive, non-transferable and terminable right to install and use, solely for the purpose of education, excluding any commercial purposes, copies of Showtime on your computer running a validly licensed copy of the operating system for which Showtime was designed for use on Windows XP, Windows Vista and Windows 7 with a valid licensed copy of Adobe Acrobat Reader. You may not modify, decompile, store or translate the software. **(b) Backup Copies.** You may also make a copy of Showtime as may be necessary for backup and archival purposes.
